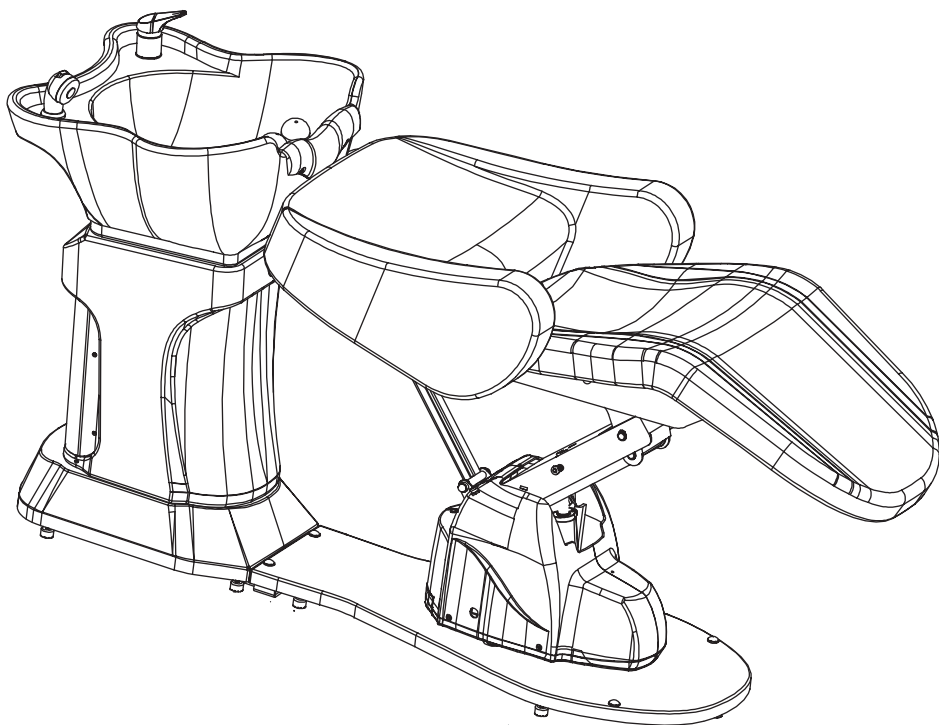

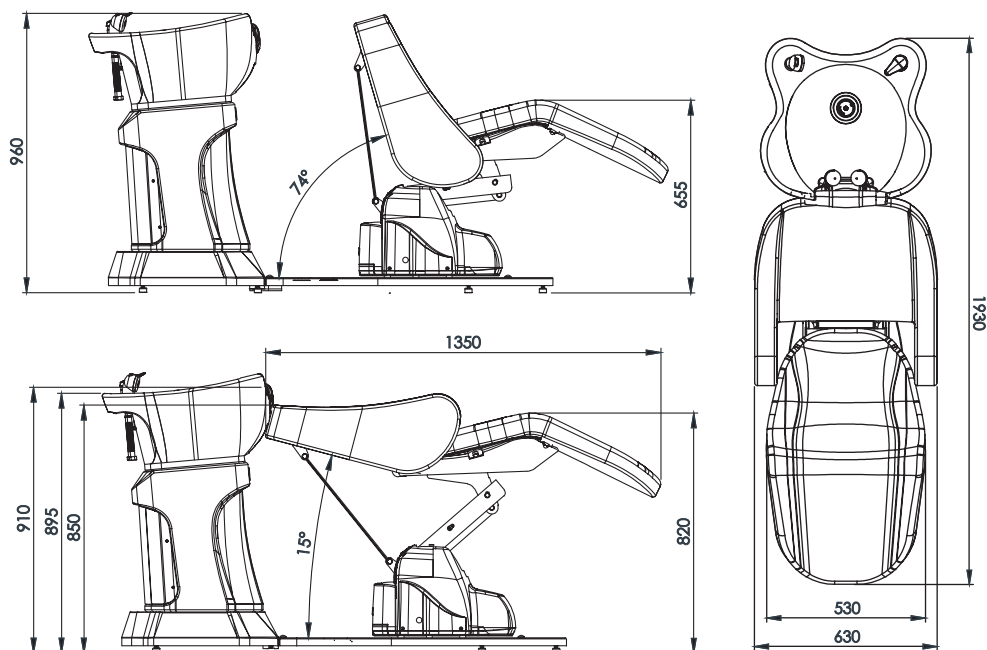

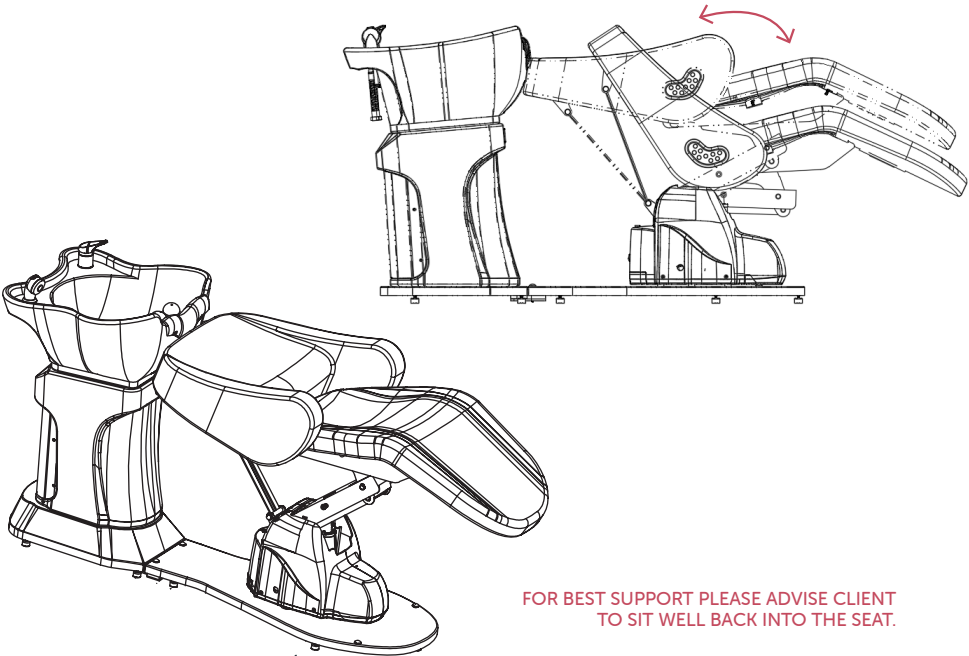
ELECTRICAL APPLIANCE SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Professional Installation: Have a qualified electrician install all power outlets (GPO's) according to local electrical standards.
- Power Off and Unplug: Always turn off the power and remove the plug when the appliance is not in use.
- Cleaning Precautions: Prior to cleaning chair cushions, power off and unplug the appliance.
- Cord Protection: Avoid damaging the power cord by avoiding twisting, pulling, or pinching.
- Heat Sources: Keep the power cord away from heat sources to prevent potential damage.
- Extension Cord Safety: If needed, use an extension cord that complies with local electrical safety standards.
- Cord Inspection: Regularly inspect the power cord for signs of damage. Discontinue use if any damage is found and arrange for repairs or replacement.
- Damaged Cord Warning: Never operate an electrical item with a damaged power cord. Ensure the cord is in good condition before operating.

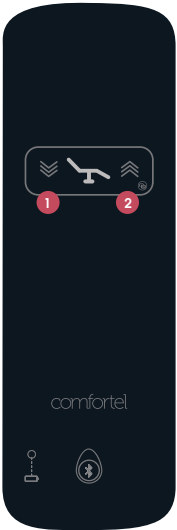

BATTERY INDICATION

When the battery power level falls below 20%, the LED will flash 4 times when a key is pressed.

When the battery has been changed, the LED will be lit for 4 seconds after the first keypress.

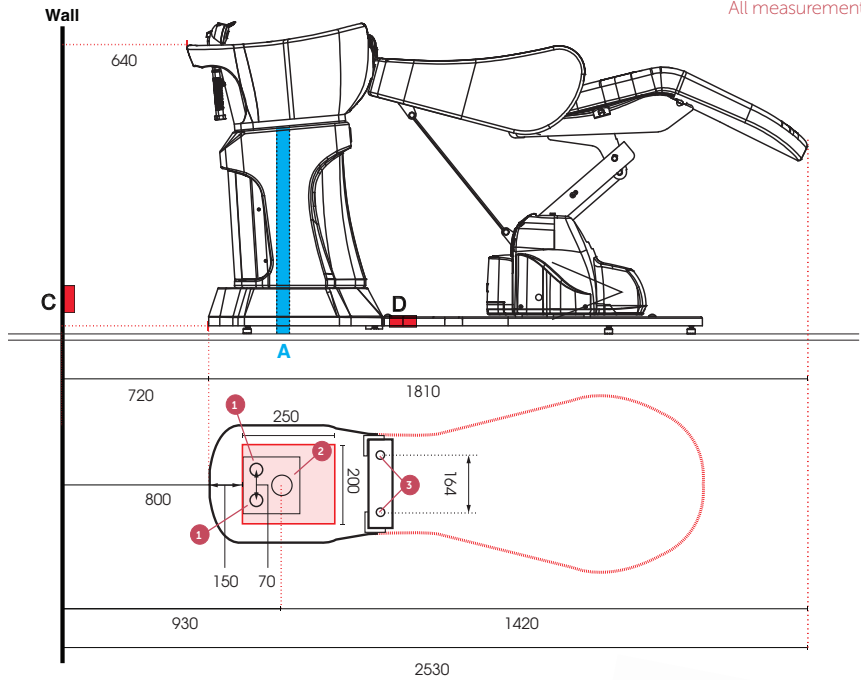
CHANGING THE BATTERY

A standard CR2032 coin cell battery is required.

Open the battery cover on the back using a coin or a similar tool to turn the arrow counterclockwise from the locked state to the unlocked state.

PLUMBING ACCESS OPTIONS

Determine the best way to connect plumbing

A PLUMBING

From under the basin stand connect plumbing to the floor.

ELECTRICAL ACCESS FOR RECLINE AND HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT

Determine the best way to connect Power.

OPTION C+D: POWER OUTLET (GPO)

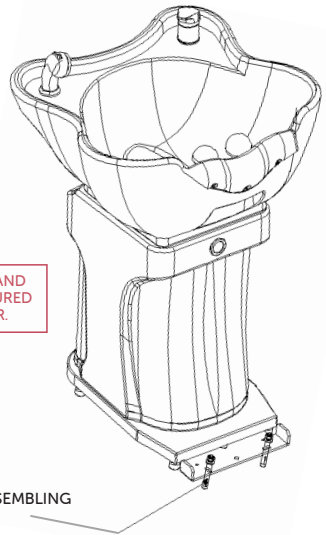
Install Power Outlet (GPO) to the wall (option C) or under the chair (option D). Use a recessed, waterproof GPO for under the chair option.

BEFORE PLUMBING INSTALLATION SECURE AND BOLT DOWN BASIN STAND

Secure the basin stand base to the floor using appropriate fixings (not supplied).



THE BASIN STAND
MUST BE SECURED

EXPANSION BOLT ASSEMBLING



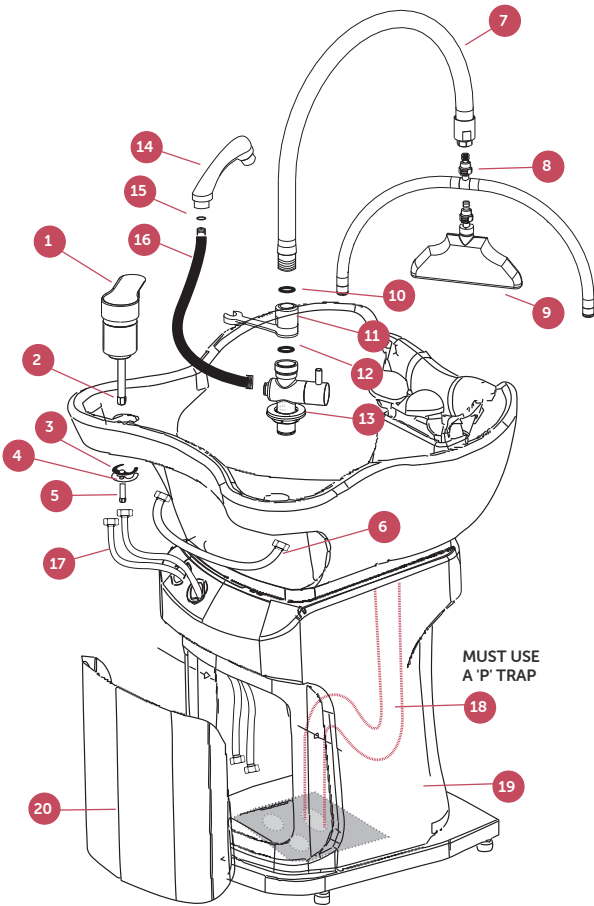
CRITICAL PLUMBING NOTICE

It is mandatory that all plumbing work be carried out exclusively by a licensed plumber.



IMPORTANT ELECTRICAL SAFETY NOTICE

All power outlets (GPO's) must be installed by a licensed electrician in compliance with local electrical standards.



BEFORE INSTALLING CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING:

Read instructions first, wear gloves/eye protection, and turn off water at the isolation valves or mains before you start.

PLUMBING & INSTALLATION

Install Flick Mixer

- Insert Flick Mixer (1) with O-Ring (2) into the basin hole.
- From underneath, secure with washers (3)(4) and long nut (5).
- Connect Small Water Supply Hose (6) to the tap.

Assemble Diverter, Showerhead Cradle & Flexible Arm

- Fit Rubber Washer (12) to the top of the Diverter Valve (13)
- Fit Showerhead Cradle (11) into the diverter valve body
- Fit Rubber Washer (10) and screw the Quick Connect Flexible Arm (7) to the top outlet of the diverter

Install Diverter Assembly into Basin

- Insert the assembled Diverter Valve into the basin hole.
- Secure the cradle from underneath using the fixing nut. Connect the other end of the Small Water Supply Hose (6) to the base of the cradle

Install Showerhead

- Insert Rubber Washer and Connect Black Showerhead Hose (16) to Showerhead (14) and to the side port of Diverter Valve (13)
- Insert Showerhead into the cradle (11) on the basin

Connect Hot and Cold Water Supply

Attach the hot & cold (1/2" connection) braided hoses (17) from the Flick Mixer (1) to your hot and cold plumbing. Hot and cold water are supplied from the wall or from the floor, depending on the salon's plumbing layout.

Attach HeadSpa Heads

Fit the QuickConnect Flexible Arm with Head Spa Rainfall Head (8) or Head Spa Waterfall Head (9)

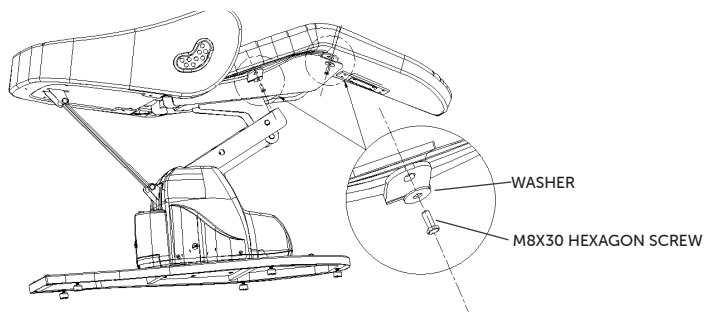
Stand-Basin Assembly Plumbing connection

Connect Basin to P trap (18) (not supplied) to the waste outlet. Follow standard plumbing practices to complete installation.

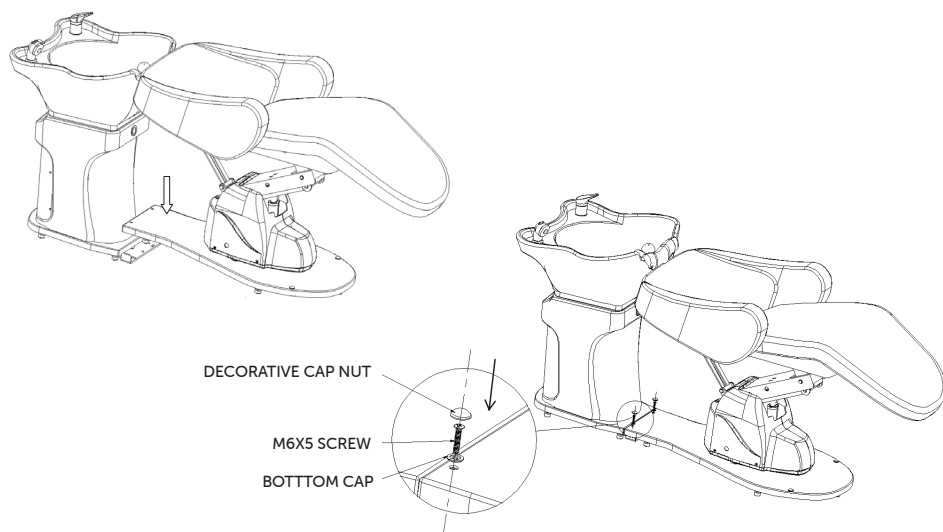

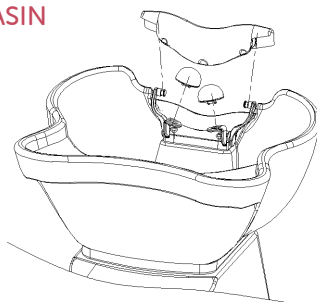


CONNECT SEAT TO THE BASIN

Using the provided bolts, secure the Chair to the Basin Stand.

UPHOLSTERY

All upholstery needs some care; good housekeeping will help to prolong the life of any upholstered products. Avoid extreme temperatures. Extreme cold can make your vinyl prone to cracking, while extreme heat can cause permanent stretching. Avoid exposing your products to direct sunlight for prolonged periods of time.

ALWAYS FOLLOW THE CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

- Wipe with a clean colourfast cloth dampened with mild alkaline free soap and luke warm water. Do not wet excessively.
- Remove all traces of any cleaning product by wiping with fresh water and a clean cloth.
- Dry with a soft, clean cloth.
- Stubborn grime may require gentle scrubbing with a soft brush.

Staining with Hair Colour or Bleach

- **Removing difficult stains such as professional hair colour or bleach is recommended that it is cleaned immediately.**
- Hair colour & bleach reacts to all surfaces the same as it does to hair. If hair colour is able to develop & penetrate the surface of the material, it may be impossible to remove.
- Treat all stains promptly as per our cleaning instructions
