
- Check all connections on a yearly basis

STRUCTURE OF PRODUCTS

- This product consists of control box, motor, wooden part, hardware, plastic parts and leather. Among them the control box is controlling the operation of the motors and the hand controller.
- This product includes angle adjustment of the backrest, angle adjustment of the seat cushion and lifting adjustment which is an overall and integral structure.

OPERATION INSTRUCTION

ALUNA ELECTRIC SPA TABLE REMOTE



NO.	DESCRIPTION	OPERATION	
1	Backrest moves up	Backrest goes up smoothly by pressing the button.	
2	Backrest moves down	Backrest goes down smoothly by pressing the button.	
3	Leg rest moves up	Leg rest goes up smoothly by pressing the button.	
4	Leg rest moves down	Leg rest goes down smoothly by pressing the button.	
5	Tilt Function up	The table will tilt, raising the leg side and lowering the headrest	
6	Tilt Function down	The table will tilt in the opposite direction, raising the headrest and lowering the leg rest	
7	Height up	Height will raise up smoothly by pressing the button.	
8	Height down	Height will go down smoothly by pressing the button.	
9	One-key reset button	Press the button, the backrest angle will automatically move to the maximum, the seat cushion angle will automatically reduce to the minimum, footrest angle will automatically move to the maximum, the height of the product will automatically reach the lowest position.	
10	Safe-lock button	Keep pressing the "safe-lock button" for about two seconds, lighting up the green light around the button, all the buttons can not be operated except safe-lock button Keep pressing the safe-lock button for about two seconds again, the green button lights go out, all the buttons return to normal operation status.

11	Store Memory Button	Press and hold for 5 seconds in any position to store it as one of the three memory presets.	
12	Memory Button 1	To save a position: Press Store and Memory 1 together. The blinking light confirms the position is saved.	
13	Memory Button 2	To save a position: Press Store and Memory 2 together. The blinking light confirms the position is saved.	
14	Memory Button 3	To save a position: Press Store and Memory 3 together. The blinking light confirms the position is saved.	



TROUBLESHOOTING

The Fault Phenomenon	Reason	Solution
	The power cord is unconnected or not plugged well.	1. Connect the power cord or plug it well.
	2. Poor quality of the hand controller.	2. Replace the hand controller.
	3. Poor quality of the control box.	
	4. Rupture of motor tail.	Please contact maintenance center or supplier for troubleshooting.
Can't move up or down normally	5. Motor was damaged.	
	6. Pressing the button, the bed did not move.	Confirm that the locking function is off (the locking button indicator is off). If the problem is still not resolved after the above steps, please contact the local dealer or service center.
	The rotating parts are short of lubricating oil.	1. Add lubricating oil.
Abnormal Sound	Rotating positions (such as hinge, POM sets) are short of lubricating oil.	2.Add lubricating oil.
	3. Motor quality problems.	3. Replace the motor.




LEVELING YOUR TABLE


Leveling or balancing, your table is very important during initial setup and routine maintenance. Your table is equipped with leveling feet that can adjast to uneven floors.

TO ADJUST THE LEVELER FEET:

- 1. Place the table in the position you plan to use it.
- 2. To determine which foot needs adjusting, attempt to 'rock' your table. If there is any movement, the leg that is lifting is the one that will need adjusting.
- 3. Raise table height approximately 6 inches.
- 4. Using your hand, or a wrench if necessary, turn the leveling foot in the needed direction. (Counterclockwise will lower the overall height, clockwise will raise the overall height)







HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR UPHOLSTERY

IN AN EFFORT TO ENSURE YOUR PRODUCT QUALITY AND HELP YOU MAINTAIN THE LIFE OF YOUR TABLE, WE HAVE TESTED SEVERAL PREVENTIVE STEPS IN ORDER TO ADVISE YOU REGARDING HOW TO PROTECT THE UPHOLSTERY ON YOUR TABLE AND ACCESSORIES.

- Avoid storing your table in extreme cold temperatures as excessive coldness will cause cracking. Avoid storing your table in extremely hot temperatures as excessive heat will cause the upholstery to stretch and pucker. Be sure to keep your table away from heaters, electrical appliances, and direct sunlight.
- Clean your upholstery daily.
- We recommend cleaning your upholstery with a mild detergent to protect it against oil stains and dirt, which will cause cracking and permanent stains.
- We recommend a mild mixture of anti-bacterial dish soap with water in a spray bottle. Spray the table with the solution and wipe down the table with a clean damp towel.
- Use both ends of the table. Occasionally, switch the face rest from one end of the table to the other to avoid uneven use.
- Protect your table from general abrasions, cuts, and punctures.

- 1. The use of alcohol with dry out the vinyl and cause it to crack.
- 2. Prolonged exposure to extreme temperatures may cause damage to vinyl.
